



Your PPO prescription drug benefit co-payments at a glance (effective January 1, 2010)

Show this to your doctor and discuss ways to pay less for the medications you need. If you need a medication on a long-term basis, you'll save money by using your mail-order pharmacy, **Medco By Mail**, instead of a drugstore. We'll deliver up to a 90-day supply of your medication right to you—and **standard shipping is free**.

*If you purchase a brand-name medication when a generic medication is available, you will pay the brand payment, plus the difference in cost between the brand and the generic.

Annual deductible:

There is a \$25 per person/\$75 per family annual deductible that applies to both mail order and retail prescriptions for **brand-name drugs**.

- ✓ For long-term prescriptions, use Medco By Mail to avoid paying more
- ✓ For short-term prescriptions, such as antibiotics, use a retail pharmacy

As a Medco member, you can go to any of **nearly 60,000 retail pharmacies**, including most major drugstores.
