

eChecks

What are eChecks?

eCheck is a type of payment account that performs an electronic ACH withdrawal from your checking account. When setting up the new payment account, you will enter the account number and routing number of your checking account.

What does this mean for me?

You will now see eCheck as an option in the Payment Account setup screen. While you can setup a payment account for eChecks as an eFiling user in California, only the listed courts will allow the eCheck payment type. Due to the limited availability, when selecting the payment account in the fees section of your filing, the eCheck payment account will only appear at the accepting locations.

Are there any fees associated with using an eCheck as a payment account?

There is a \$1 flat rate convenience fee for using an eCheck.
