3 GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF  
4 AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR  
OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

5 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the  
6 September 15, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the  
7 Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the September 10, 2020 request for an  
8 emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Barbara County (“Court”), this Court  
9 HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

10 1. Any Judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of  
11 the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than an additional 30 days,  
12 applicable only to cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline  
13 otherwise would expire from September 17, 2020, through October 16, 2020, inclusive (Gov.  
14 Code, §68116(1)(10): Executive Order N-38-20 (03-27-20)

15 2. The Court will collaborate with local justice partners to conduct a trial at an  
16 earlier date, if a court may do so in compliance with applicable health and safety laws,  
17 regulations, and orders, including the use of remote technology.

18 3. Hold sessions anywhere in the county, including in correctional and juvenile  
19 detention facilities, from September 17, 2020 to October 16, 2020.

20 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
